Posts

- = Blog (usually appear as your HOME page)
- You can: categorize, tag, add pictures/videos (*Add Media*), edit, delete them, make public/private, change publication date, add links within text

Tag VS Category (to sort and categorize and better retrieve)

EX: Brownies

Category: Baking or dessert

Tag: chocolate, walnuts, brownies

Pages

- You can: categorize (NOT tag) add pictures/videos (*Add Media*), edit, delete, make public/private, change publication date, add links within text
- Have parent pages (main tabs and sub-tabs)
 - Ex: About (parent page)
 - Values
 - Experience
 - Education
 - Order of pages: done on the Page (right side)
 - Smallest number will bring page to top
 - Ex: About (no parent)
 - Values (1) (parent to About)
 - Experience (2) (parent to About)
 - Education (3) (parent to About)
 - NOTE: Some themes do NOT allow for parent pages

Links

- Can be categorized
- In alphabetical order

Appearance

- Change theme (free and NOT free)
- Customize (free and NOT free)
 - Includes colors, header, front, site title (including tagline)
- Widgets (small applications with limited functionality)
 - Ex: archives, calendar, blog stats, Flickr, Goodreads, Instagram, links, RSS, etc.
- Header (can also be done through *Customize*)
- Background (image or colour)
